

## Circles Initiative

Overall Program Need: \$40,000

# Housing and Homeless Services

Overall Program Need: \$100,000



Invest in a path for families with children to **move from homelessness to permanent housing**. A section of our Hart Apartments is dedicated to providing families with the stability and critical supports for up to 90 days.

This time allows them to get back on their feet after a crisis, secure employment, and save for a rental deposit and first month's rent—key steps toward long-term housing security.

# Emergency Assistance Fund

Overall Program Need: \$40,000



Invest in stabilizing families in crisis through the Emergency Assistance Fund. When an unexpected expense threatens a family's stability, **this fund covers essential needs** such as rent and rental deposits, bus passes, emergency food, and other critical costs that can't wait. The key to preventing an employment, food, or housing crisis is assisting families through these temporary setbacks.


